I've been to Los Angeles where there are movie theaters with the most technology in the world, but the one that I remember best is the Alamo Drafthouse in Austin, Texas. It has completely changed the way we experience movies.

The Alamo Drafthouse first opened in Austin in 1997 but there are now 22 locations all around the US. The theaters are very comfortable and you can eat and drink inside them. They don't just serve the usual popcorn, but the chef in the restaurant kitchen prepares food after he has watched a film. He invents new dishes to match each film. I recommend going when the movie *Murder on the Orient Express* is showing because the restaurant serves delicious burgers made with salmon. If you are allergic to fish, they serve the Orient Express chicken burger or vegan burger. For dessert, there is a special strawberry yogurt jam with ice cream.

One thing that the Alamo Drafthouse has that other movie theaters don't, is a store where you can buy posters and 3D glasses for the 3D theater where the seats move with the movie. So, for example, if the screen shows people driving along in a car, your movie theater seat moves around with them. There are also other special effects such as perfumes, wind and smoke, rain and lightning. It makes the film scarier and you might jump out of your seat!
