TULUM — A PLACE OF BEAUTY AND PEACE

Have you ever heard of Tulum? If you haven't, you should make plans to come here SOON!

Where is it?

Tulum is in the Yucatan Peninsula, in Mexico, about one hour from Playa del Carmen. There are several flight arrivals at Cozumel International Airport every day from the United States, with direct flights from many of the big cities. Make a reservation today!

What's special about Tulum?

UNESCO made Tulum a World Heritage Site in 1987. Since then, many visitors from all over the world have visited the area. Once you are here, you will visit amazing Mayan ruins (buildings that are more than 1,000 years old!) and you will be fascinated by the many different types of plants and animals that live here.

Where can I stay?

Tulum is a very old town but you can find modern hotels to stay in if you want to. Or maybe you prefer hostels or campsites. You'll be surprised at the variety of places to stay. Tulum has something for everyone.

How do I get around?

If you don't want to spend a lot of money, you have several choices. You can use your two feet, or you can rent a bicycle. You could also get an inexpensive ride in a *colectivo*. It's a small bus that can sometimes be extremely crowded. The fare is usually about 20-25 pesos (\$1.00-\$1.50) for a 15-minute ride.

When is the best time to visit?

If you don't like rain, don't come in June, September, or October. Those are the months that get the most rain. We think October to December are the best months. It's warm but not too hot, and there aren't any hurricanes!
